
## UNIVERSITY OF KELANIYA- GUIDELINES FOR WRITING PROTOCOLS

## GUIDELINES FOR WRITING PROTOCOLS TO ETHICS REVIEW COMMITTEE UNIVERSITY OF KELANIYA

The protocol should have following documents/information. Three copies must be submitted with the application. If you are filling Annexure 1 for research involving animals or Annexure II involving humans, don't include this document.

- 1. The "Introduction" and the "Justification" should be limited to one page of the protocol.
- 2. Following documents
  - I. Questionnaire (if applicable) in Sinhala/English/Tamil<sup>1</sup>
  - II. Informed Consent Form in Sinhala/English/Tamil<sup>2</sup>
  - III. Participant Information sheet in Sinhala/English/Tamil<sup>3</sup>
- 3. Summary of the proposal (3 copies) of no more than one page (300 words). Your project summary must include the following and provide with the given sequence;
  - I Title
  - II Objective
  - III Study Design
  - IV Study setting
  - V Study population
  - VI Sample size
  - VII Method of data collection
  - VIII Proposed data analysis
  - IX Main ethical issues
- 5. Version of the protocol, questionnaire, Participant information sheet, and the Consent form (i.e. if you are submitting for the first time, it is identified as the <u>1<sup>st</sup> version</u>, whereas the current submission is you revised version and submitted for the second time, it is named as the <u>2<sup>nd</sup> version</u>) must be indicated on the top right hand corner of all your documents.



- 6. Protocol must be typed, single-spaced, in "Times New Roman" with 12 point, All margins must be of 1", and the page number must be indicated at the bottom right corner of each page.
- 7. Name of the investigator will be deleted from all documents to ensure the transparency of the review process.
