1.2. This is a 30 credit, two semester (one academic year) taught course

1.3. The Postgraduate Diploma in Art History consists of 6 compulsory Course Units and a compulsory field experience period of 20-days.

2. **Duration:** Minimum duration is ONE academic year (2 Semesters) and the maximum duration is THREE academic years (6 Semesters) inclusive of a one-year extension.

3. 3.1. Grading system:

Note: A candidate should complete the all course units he/she has registered for. If he/she fails to produce valid reasons for not completing a particular course unit, a grade of ‘E’ will be given.

9.2 Re-sit examination

A candidate may re-sit a course where he/she has obtained a grade less than '**B-**'. However, the maximum grade that could result from a re-sit is a grade '**B-**'. In the event a student obtains a lower grade while attempting to better the grade he/she will be entitled to the previous grade.

9.3. Award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Art History

9.31 Pass

A candidate is eligible for the Postgraduate Diploma in Art History he/she obtains,

- I. Grades of B- or better in each of the course unit offered and achieves a minimum GPA of 2.70 and satisfactorily completes the mandatory field experience period, and
- II. Completes the relevant requirements within a period of two academic years.

9.3.2 Merit Pass

A candidate shall be awarded a Merit Pass provided he/she

- I. Obtains grades of 'A-' or better in each of the course units offered and achieves a minimum GPA of 3.70, and
- II. Completes the relevant requirements in the first attempt

9.3.3 Distinction Pass

A candidate shall be awarded a Distinction Pass provided he/she

- I. Obtains grades of 'A' or better in each of the course units offered and achieves a minimum GPA of 4.00, and
- II. Completes the relevant requirements in the first attempt.
