

Total of 465 graduates have passed out from the Faculty of Commerce and Management which is 15% of the total output of the University. And, 31% of the output, the majority, which is the postgraduate output of the University is 974 students. In 2016, the Faculty of Humanities has released 406 graduates which represents 13% of the total output of the University. 208 graduates, that is 7% of the total output of the University, has passed out from the Faculty of Medicine. 379 students, which is 12% of the total output of the University, has passed out from the Faculty of Science. 22% of the total output of the University, which is 688 students have passed out from the Faculty of Sciences.






