In the year 2017, a total of 3700 undergraduates has been passed out from the University.




Figure 1: Graduate Output of the University

A total of 533 graduates has passed out from the Faculty of the Commerce and Management Studies which is 14% of the total output of the University. And, 34% of the output, majority, which is the postgraduate output of the University is 1269 students. In 2017, the Faculty of Humanities has released 452 graduates which represent 12% of the total output while 220 graduates, that is 6% of the total output, has passed out from the Faculty of Medicine. 430 students, which is 12% of the total output, have passed out from the Faculty of Science and 22% of the total output of the University, which is 796 students have passed out from the Faculty of Science Sciences.



# 2. Graduate Output of the Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies

533 students have passed the final examination out of 646 undergraduates who sat for the final examination. Thus, the total passed percentage in Faculty Commerce and Management Studies is 83%.




Figure 2: Output by the Result obtained Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies




Figure 3:Graduate Output by Gender, Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies




Figure 4:Output by the Result obtained Faculty of Humanities




Figure 5:Grasduate Output by Gender Faculty of Humanities




Figure 6: Output by Result obtained Faculty of Medicine




Figure 6: Graduate Output by Gender Faculty of Medicine




Figure 7:Output by Result obtained Faculty of Science




Figure 8:Graduate Output by Gender Faculty of Science




Figure 9:Output by Result obtained Faculty of Social Sciences




Figure 10:Graduate Output by Gender Faculty of Social Science

#### 8.1 Graduate Output by the Faculties


According to the statistics, table 19, shows the output of the Faculties <u>considering the total</u> <u>number sat for the final examination</u>.




Figure 12: Percentage of Graduates who obtained a class




Figure 13:Graduate Output by Gender of University
